Workshop Registration:

Retreat applicants must be a minimum of 19 years of age. Please go to our website, www.vgfa.org, or read the retreat brochure for workshop descriptions, including length of classes, dates, level of difficulty and machine requirements. **Students must supply their own sewing machines for all classes requiring machines.** Workshop supply lists and other relevant information will be posted on our website by end November. Workshop spaces will be assigned on a "first registered - first served" basis. Should you wish to change workshops after you have submitted your registration form, there will be an administration charge of \$25 for each change you wish to make.

Self-directed Work:

Retreat applicants applying for self-directed / independent work with accommodation and meals only - specify desired days with a second choice if possible. The accommodation coordinator will confirm availability of both work space and accommodation.

Enrolment:

Applicants will be accepted on a first come, first served basis provided the minimum 20% deposit is mailed with the registration form. Final acceptance is conditional upon receipt of the second payment by November 15, 2009, and the balance by February 1, 2010.

Deposit and Payment of Fees:

A non-refundable deposit of 20% of total fees is required with your registration. The balance is due in stages, 30% of total by November 15, 2009 and the remaining 50% by February 1, 2010.

Cancellation Policy:

The guild will not refund any deposits or workshop fees, unless workshops are cancelled due to insufficient enrolment, in which case the VGFA will have no liability beyond the refund of deposits or fees paid. If you are unable to attend a workshop for which you have paid a deposit or the fee in full, please arrange for another person to take your place in the workshop(s), and notify the VGFA of the substitution. The guild will maintain a waiting list for workshop spaces.

Travel arrangements:

Please do not make travel arrangements until your workshop has been confirmed by the Vancouver Guild of Fibre Arts.

Accommodation:

Loon Lake Research & Education Center provides camp style accommodation, and the guild has arranged for shared accommodation, two to a room, for the majority of our participants. If you wish to share with a friend please note details on your registration form.

ALL BUILDINGS AND ACCOMMODATIONS ARE NON-SMOKING ENVIRONMENTS

Linens:

Please note, linens are excluded from the cost of accommodation. You must bring your own sheets, blankets, pillows and towels. The UBC Loon Lake Research and Education Center is at an elevation of 1,100 feet and can be quite cold in the early spring. Warm bedding, including a good sleeping bag, is recommended.

Meals:

The daily accommodation cost includes three meals - evening meal on the day prior to your workshop, and breakfast and lunch on the workshop day(s). Please note any allergies or dietary restrictions on page one of the registration form.

Telephones:

Cellular phones only work in limited areas at Loon Lake. There will be one telephone available to guests for incoming and outgoing calls - please bring a calling card with you if you plan to make long distance calls.

Arrival & departure times:

Plan to arrive the afternoon of the day before your workshop commences. Standard check-in time is 2:00 PM, and on your final day the check-out time is 11:00 AM. If you are travelling from outside the Vancouver / Lower Mainland area please let the accommodation coordinator know if you expect to arrive at Loon Lake before the standard check-in time.
